Nearly 1 in 4 caregivers in Arizona (23.7%) is providing care to an individual with Alzheimer's or other form of dementia.

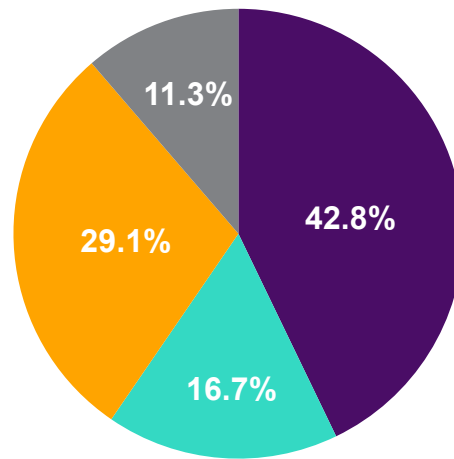
Who are dementia caregivers?

Health Effects

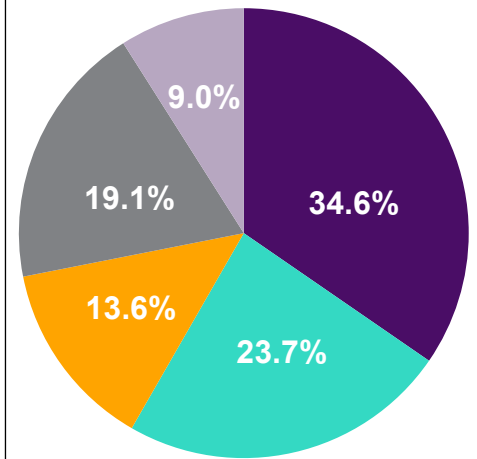
In frequent poor physical health	15.5%

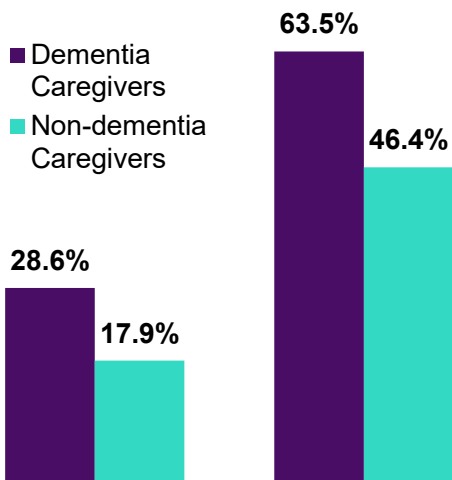

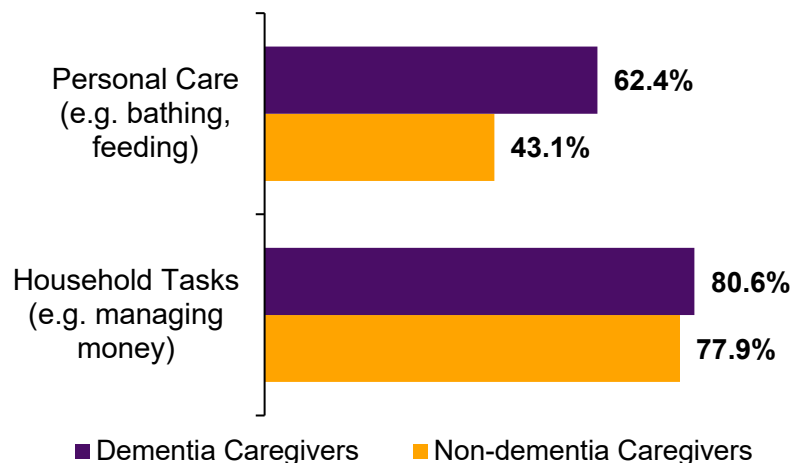
What does dementia caregiving entail?
