


DATA FROM THE 2016 BEHAVIORAL RISK FACTOR SURVEILLANCE SYSTEM

In Arkansas, <u>more than 40 percent</u> of all adults providing unpaid care to loved ones with Alzheimer's or another dementia have been doing so for at least two years.

One-third of Alzheimer's and dementia caregivers provide 20 or more hours of care per week.


Among Alzheimer's and dementia caregivers, more than two-thirds provide care to their parent of their parent-in-law.
