Nearly 1 in 6 caregivers in Nebraska (16.0%) is providing care to an individual with Alzheimer's or other form of dementia.

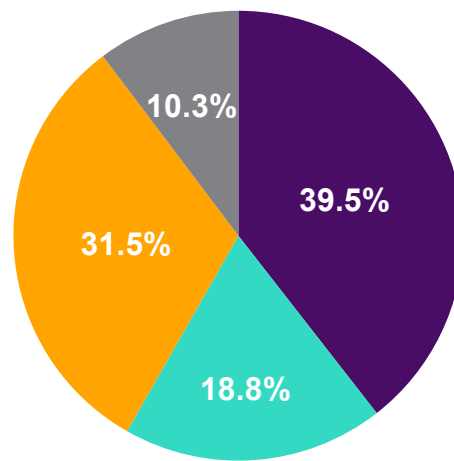
Who are dementia caregivers?

Health Effects

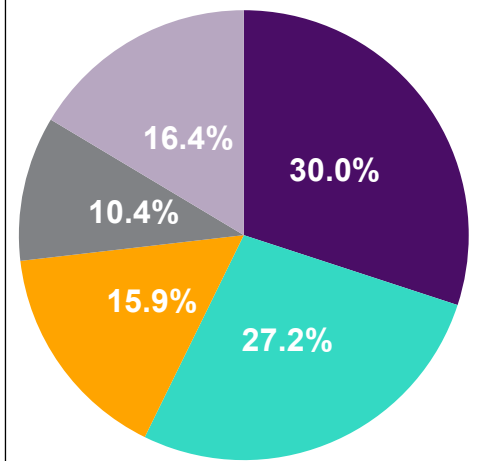
In frequent poor physical health	13.2%

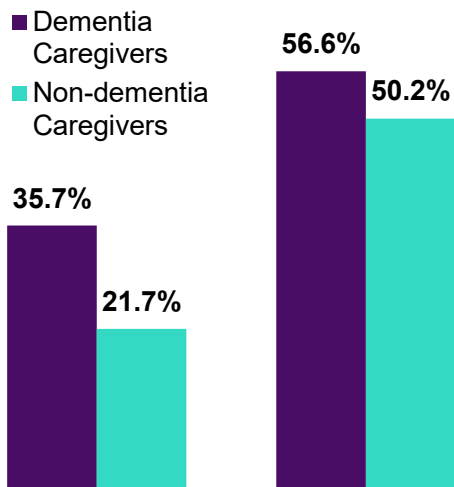

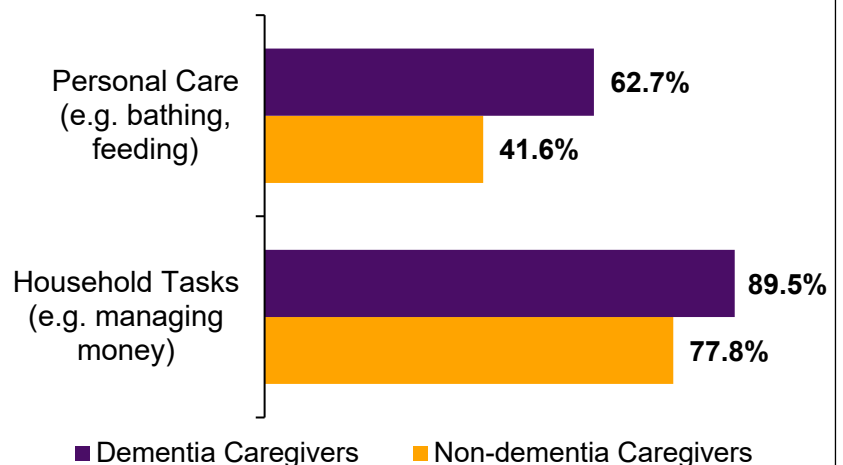
