



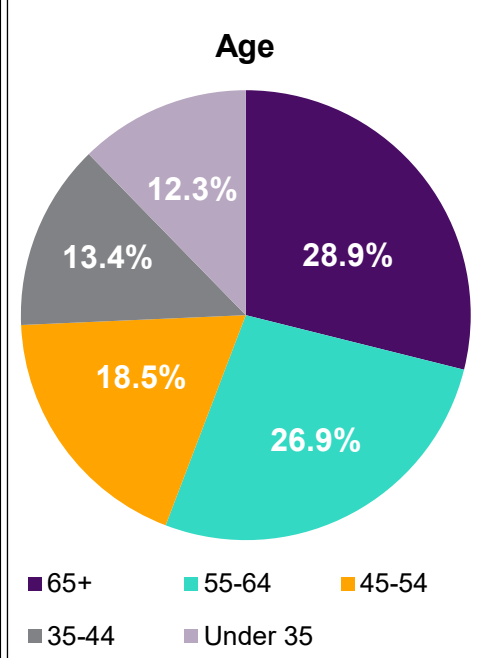
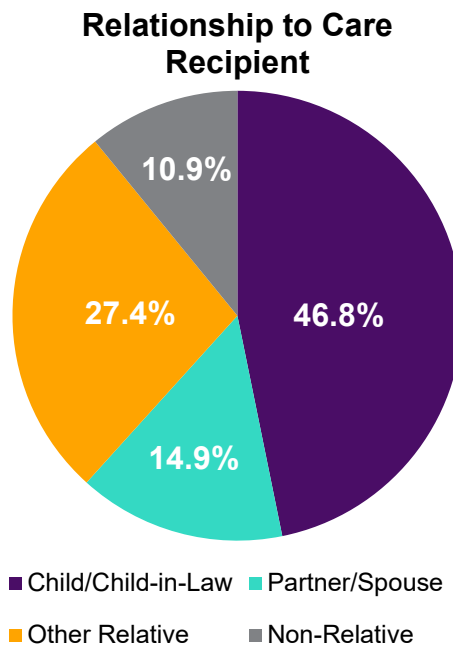

DATA FROM THE 2022 BEHAVIORAL RISK FACTOR SURVEILLANCE SYSTEM

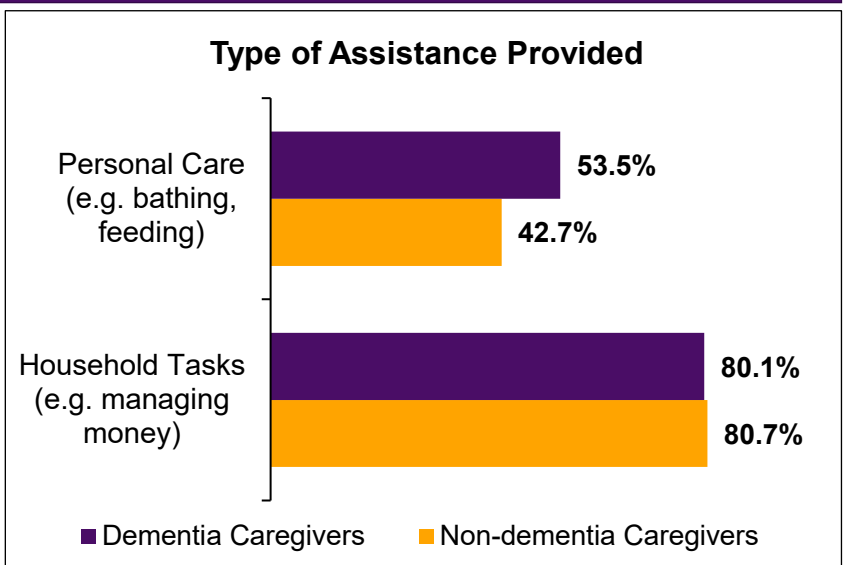
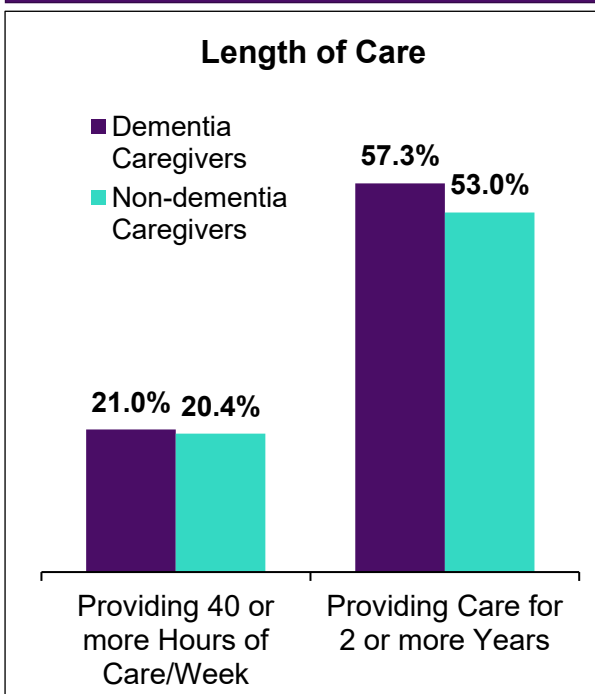
More than 1 in 4 caregivers in Oregon (25.9%) is providing care to an individual with Alzheimer's or other form of dementia.
