### DATA FROM THE 2021 BEHAVIORAL RISK FACTOR SURVEILLANCE SYSTEM


Nearly 1 in 4 caregivers in Alabama (23.5%) is providing care to an individual with Alzheimer's or other form of dementia.


## Who are dementia caregivers?

Also caring for a child	25.2%


### **Health Effects**


In frequent poor physical health	15.0%
