More than 1 in 5 caregivers in Michigan (22.9%) is providing care to an individual with Alzheimer's or other form of dementia.

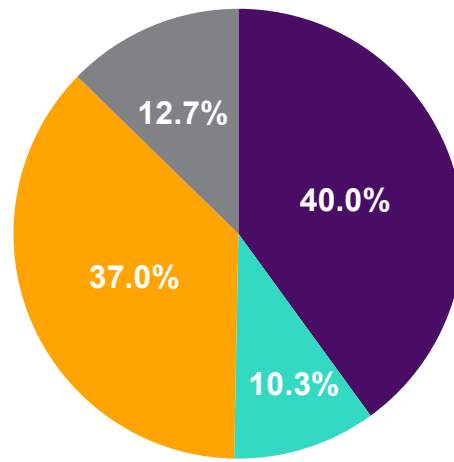

Health Effects

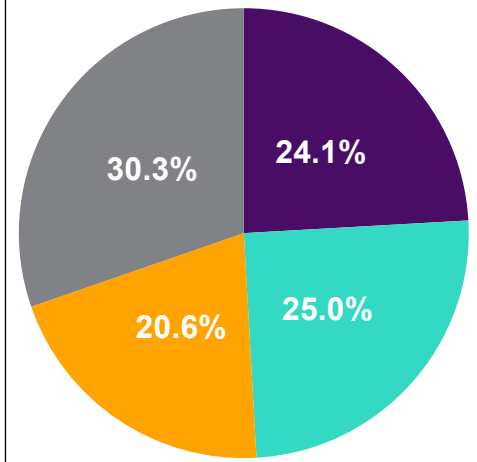
In frequent poor physical health	24.4%

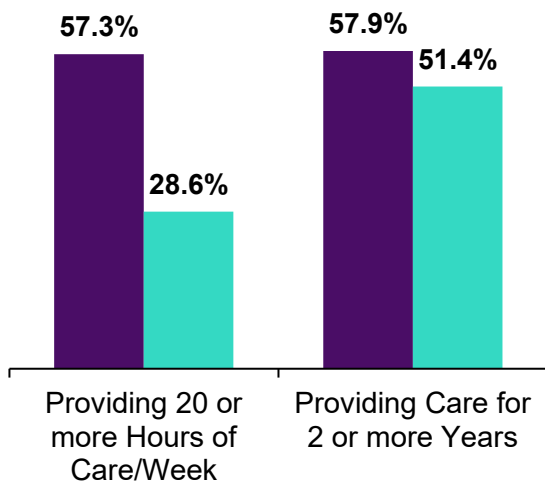

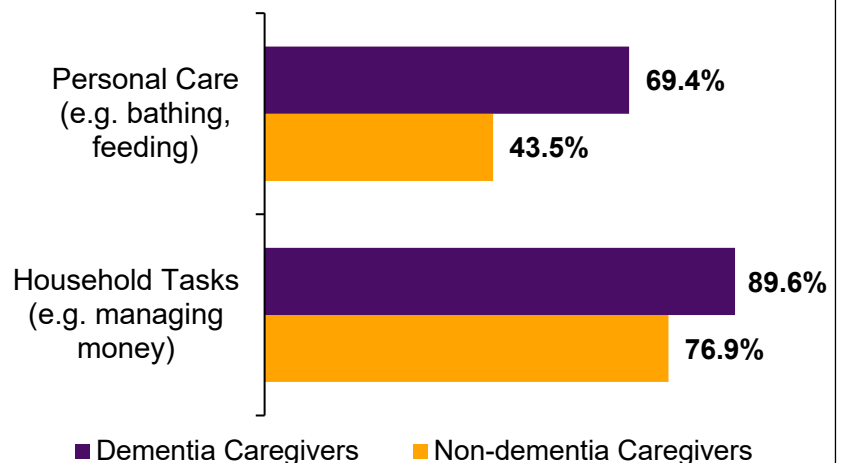
What does dementia caregiving entail?
