Nearly 1 in 4 caregivers in Pennsylvania (24.3%) is providing care to an individual with Alzheimer's or other form of dementia.

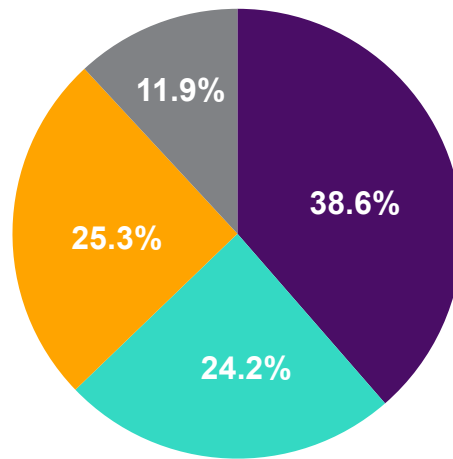

### Health Effects

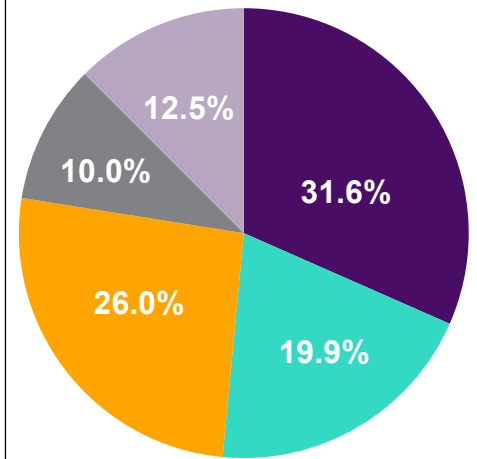
In frequent poor physical health	16.0%

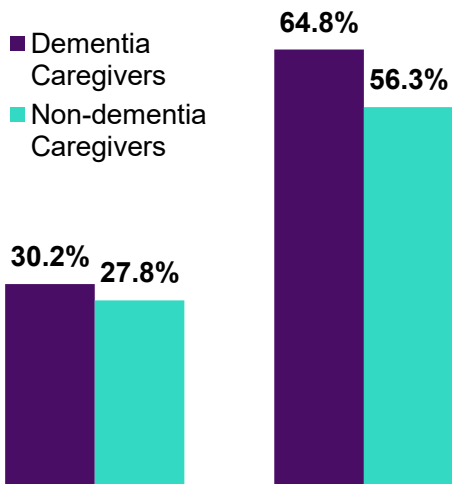

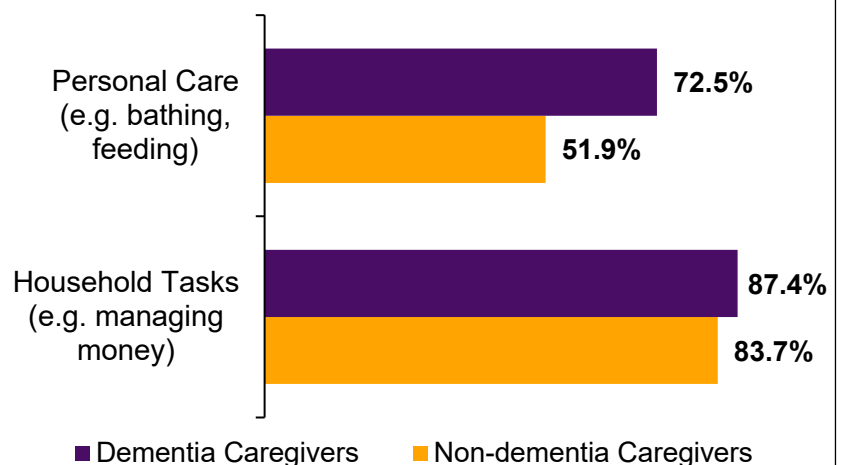
### Length of Care
