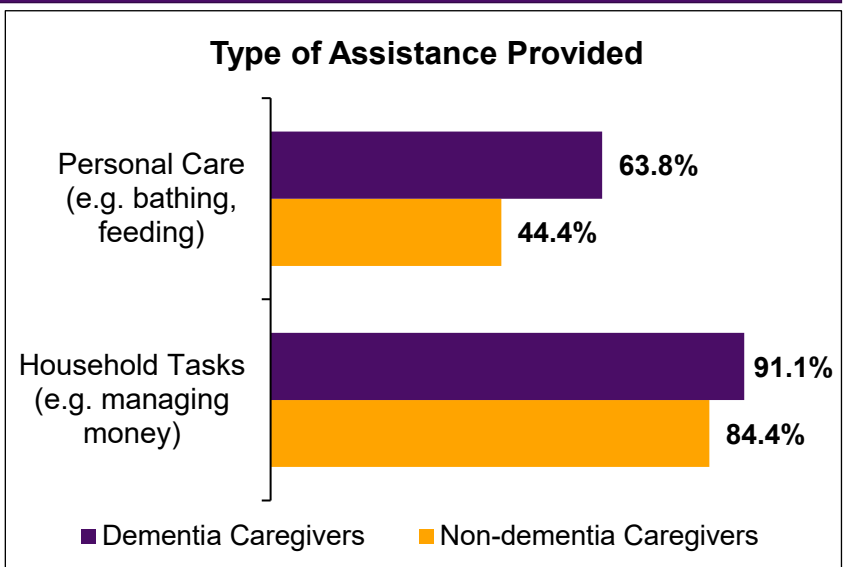
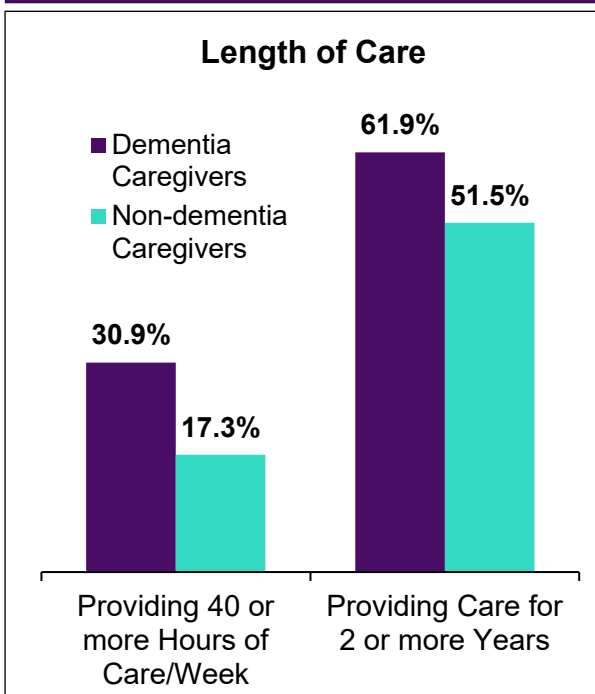
More than 1 in 5 caregivers in Colorado (22.3%) is providing care to an individual with Alzheimer's or other form of dementia.

Who are dementia caregivers?

Female	67.7%
Male	32.3%
Also caring for a child	34.8%
Health Effects	
In frequent poor physical health	15.5%
In frequent poor mental health	17.2%
History of depression	27.7%
Feels socially isolated	36.7%
