Nearly 1 in 4 adults are caregivers

CAREGIVERS provide regular care or assistance to a FRIEND or FAMILY member with a health problem or disability

CAREGIVING CAN BE

Nearly Half

have provided care for at least two years



INTENSE

Nearly 1/3 have provided care for at least 20 hours per week



WHO ARE CAREGIVERS?

56% are women

14% are 65 years old or older

36% are caring for a parent or parent-in-law

10% of caregivers are providing care to someone with dementia



HOW DO CAREGIVERS HELP?



Over 80% manage household tasks

Nearly 60% assist with personal care
