Nearly 1 in 5

**CAREGIVERS** provide regular care or assistance to a FRIEND or FAMILY member with a health problem or disability adults are caregivers

## **WHO ARE CAREGIVERS?**

58% are women

**19%** are 65 years old or older

**37%** are caring for a parent or parent-in-law

**10%** of caregivers are providing care to someone with dementia

## **FUTURE CAREGIVERS**

1 in 7 **NON-CAREGIVERS** expect to **BECOME CAREGIVERS** within 2 years

Almost 1/3 have provided care for at least 20 hours per week
