CAREGIVERS provide regular care or assistance to a FRIEND or FAMILY Nearly 1 in 5 adults are caregivers member with a health problem or disability

WHO ARE CAREGIVERS?

58% are women

19% are 65 years old or older

41% are caring for a parent or parent-in-law

10% of caregivers are providing care to someone with dementia

HOW DO CAREGIVERS HELP?



Nearly 80% manage household tasks

Over 50% assist with personal care
