



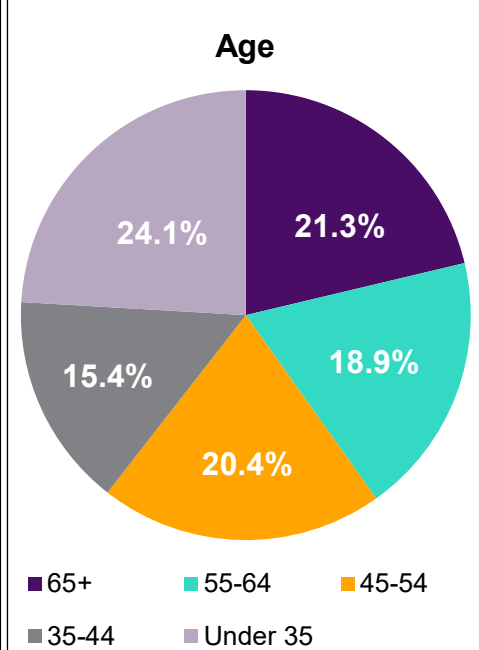
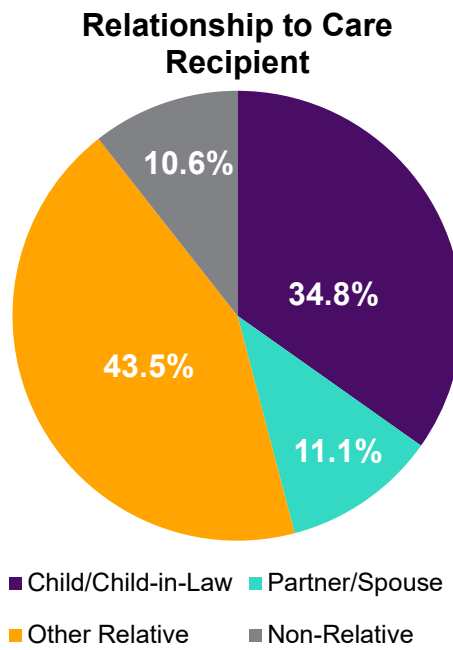
# dementia caregiving in Mississippi

DATA FROM THE 2022 BEHAVIORAL RISK FACTOR SURVEILLANCE SYSTEM

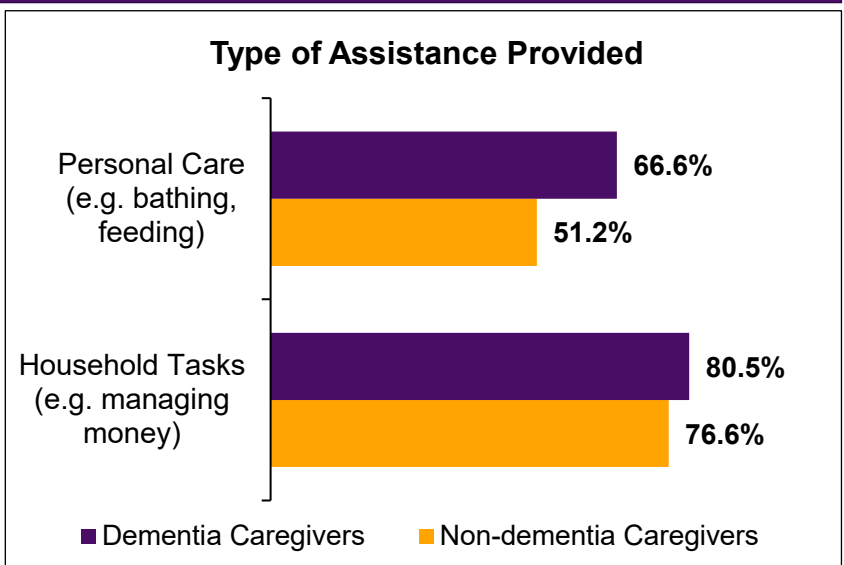
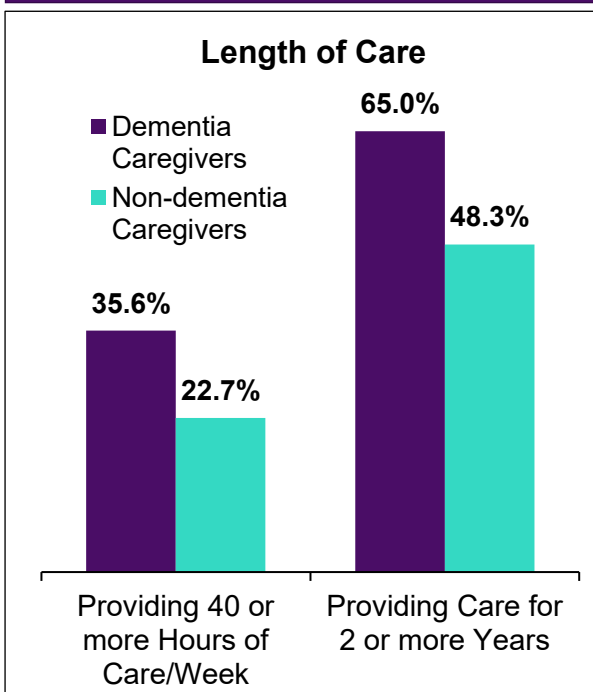
More than 1 in 6 caregivers in Mississippi (17.4%) is providing care to an individual with Alzheimer's or other form of dementia.

## Who are dementia caregivers?

Female	63.0%

In frequent poor physical health	22.2%
In frequent poor mental health	23.6%
History of depression	25.9%
Feels socially isolated	47.2%
