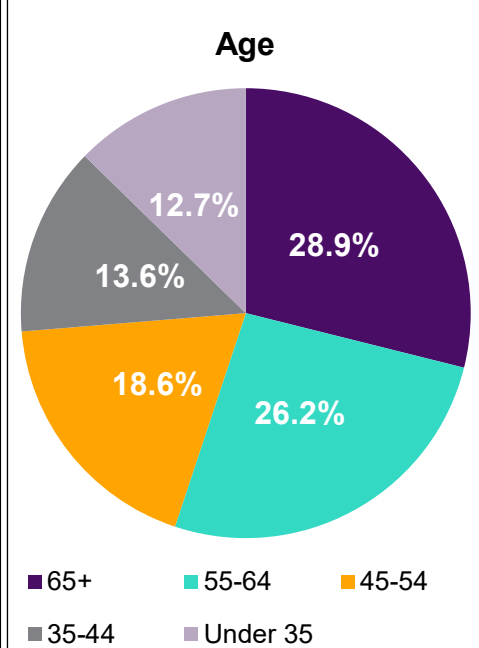
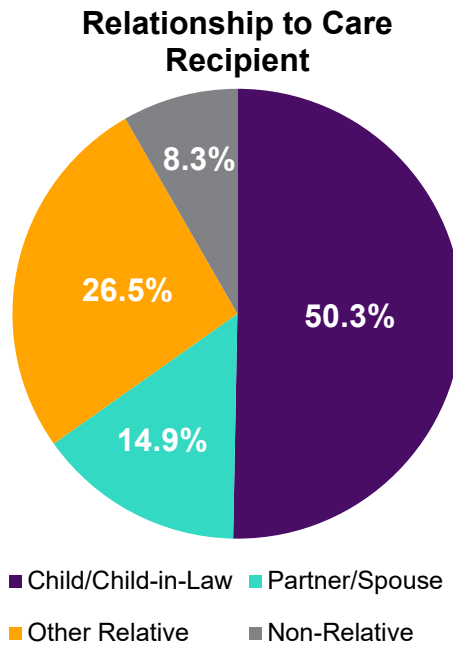
More than 1 in 5 caregivers in Missouri (22.3%) is providing care to an individual with Alzheimer's or other form of dementia.

Who are dementia caregivers?

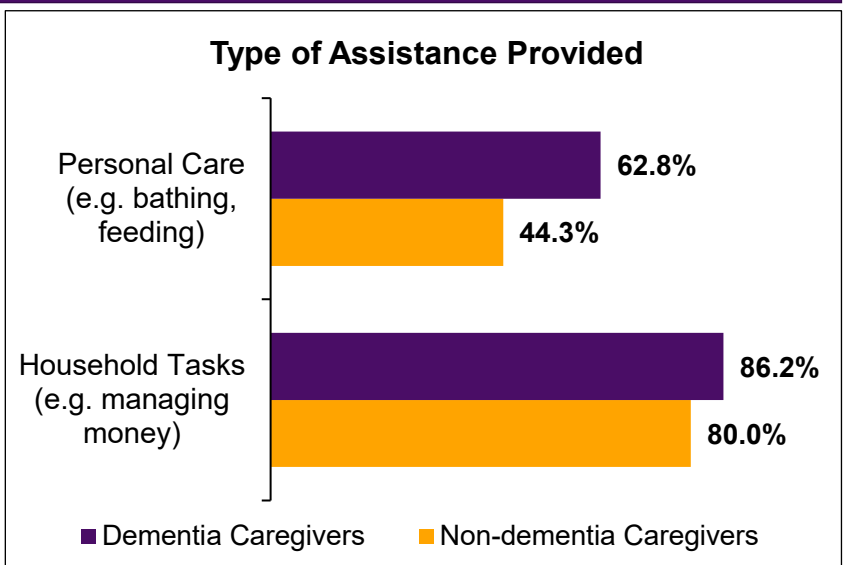
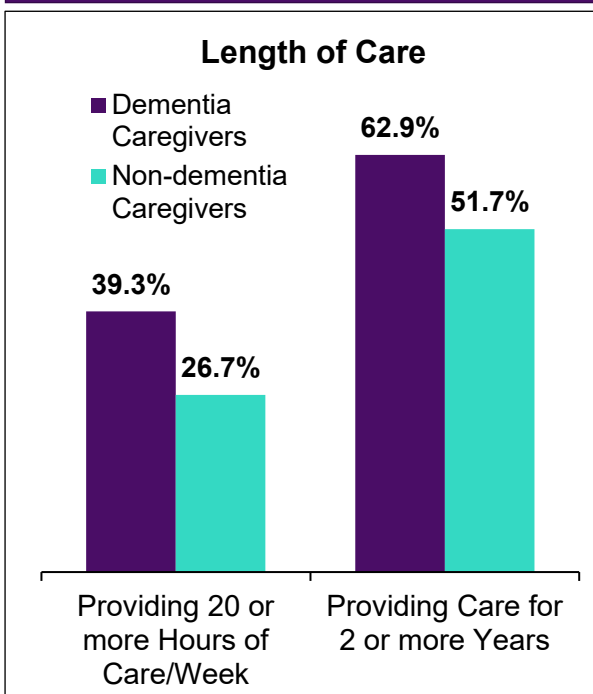
Female	68.1%
