
Nearly 1 in 5 caregivers in North Dakota (19.9%) is providing care to an individual with Alzheimer's or other form of dementia.


## Who are dementia caregivers?

Also caring for a child	22.5%


## **Health Effects**


In frequent poor physical health	8.6%
