Nearly 1 in 5 caregivers in Oklahoma (19.8%) is providing care to an individual with Alzheimer's or other form of dementia.

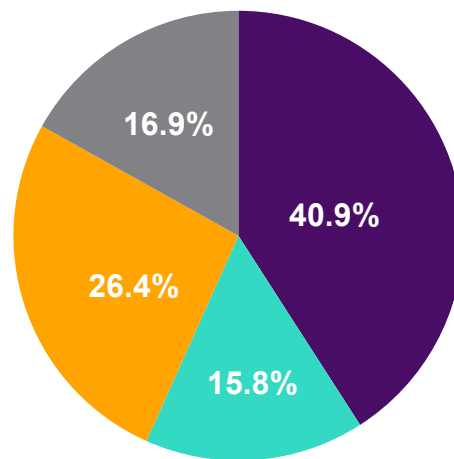

Health Effects

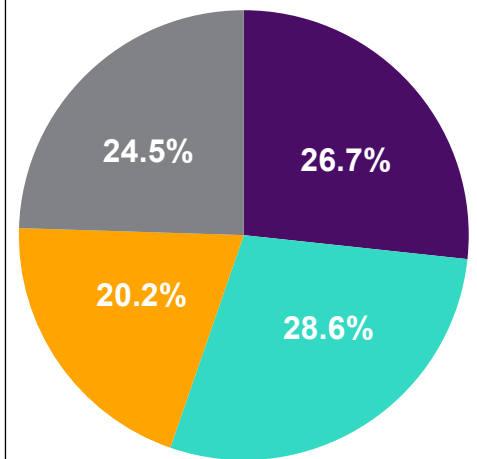
In frequent poor physical health	17.2%

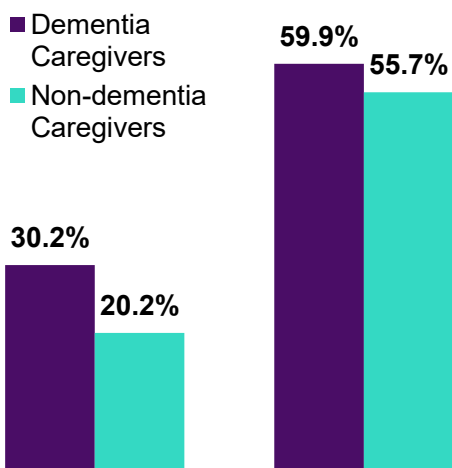

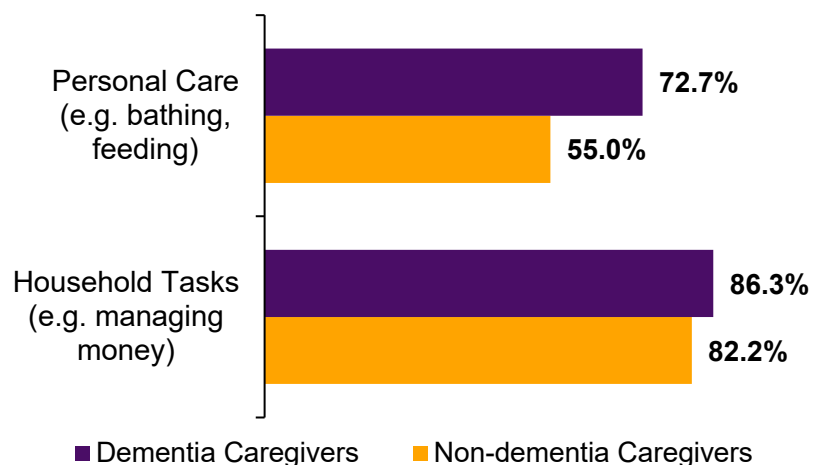
