Illinois State Veterans' Homes – Placement Options

Quality nursing and health care services are provided for Illinois Veterans with military service of one day or more during WW I, WW II, the Korean or Vietnam conflicts, or during any period of time now, or in the future, recognized by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs as a period of war. The veteran must have either been an Illinois resident upon entering the service, or have resided in the State of Illinois for one year preceding application for admittance into a Veterans' Home. Peacetime veterans with one year of HONORABLE military service may also be eligible. A spouse, or surviving spouse, may also qualify for admittance to the Quincy Veterans' Home.

Eligibility also based upon:

1. The ability of the home to provide appropriate care and services based on the veteran's medical diagnoses and assessed needs.
2. An available bed in the category required by the veteran's medical conditions and needs.

Illinois Veteran's Home at Anna – Union County

Provides light, intermediate, and skilled nursing care services to eligible veterans. Contains a 50-bed nursing care capacity and twelve beds in six apartment-style domiciliary units.
