OUR MISSION

To provide support and reduce strain on caregivers, while improving quality of life for their loved ones living with Alzheimer's or other related dementia

ELIGIBILITY

- 1 Person receiving care must be living with Alzheimer's or other related dementia
- 2 The caregiver and person living with dementia must live in the State of Missouri
- 3 The caregiver must live at the same address with the person living with dementia

TRAINING AND EDUCATION



The program provides caregivers with access to strategies for providing care at home using in-person and tele-health visits. This includes strategies for behavior management, meaningful activities, and home safety, for example. There is no cost for this service.

REIMBURSEMENT



This program provides mini grants to help with the cost of respite services, care and safety products, memory loss medications, small home modifications, and more. In some cases, the Missouri Caregiver Program may pay directly for products, avoiding out of pocket costs for the family.


ASSISTIVE TECHNOLOGY



This program provides mini grants to help with the cost of assistive technology and installation, including indoor and outdoor cameras, GPS monitoring devices, door and window alarms, etc. These items are meant to increase safety for the person living with memory loss, while providing peace of mind for the caregiver.
